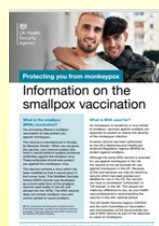

NEW! PROTECTING YOU FROM MONKEY-POX: INFORMATION ON THE SMALLPOX VACCINATION

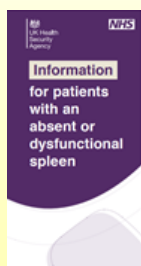
