Evidence Searches

Our evidence search service aims to deliver highquality information to support you in your local clinical and commissioning decisions. Depending on the information request(s), evidence searches include one or more of the following:

- Guidelines, reports, and grey literature.
- Journal articles including systematic reviews and primary research.
- Local and national case studies of services and/or interventions, including their impact and challenges.

To request an evidence search, please fill in a <u>form</u> and return it to <u>library.sfht@nhs.net</u>. Alternatively, you can email <u>mandy.tidswell@nhs.net</u> and <u>yvonne.finnigan1@nhs.net</u>.

Once we receive your request, we recommend having a brief meeting via Teams to discuss the search. Standard time for completion is approx. 10 days (depending on the complexity of the search).

Virtual Library & Knowledge Service Induction

A reminder that you can learn about all the services we offer by enrolling on our virtual library induction. The induction is split into two eLearning packages:

- Virtual Library Induction for ICB Staff
- Making the most of e-resources for ICB staff

To enrol, you will first need to register with the <u>Sherwood Learning Hub</u>.

- Click on Create new account at the bottom of the page.
- You will then receive an email on how to complete your registration.
- Once registration is completed, go to the <u>Sherwood Learning Hub</u> and **Log in.**
- At the top of the page click **Courses**.
- In the Search courses box type virtual library induction.
- Click on the link Virtual Library Induction for ICB Staff.
- Alternatively, click on Admin and Clerical to the left of the Search courses box. Select ICB Resources.
- Remember to **Log Out** by clicking the icon at the top right of the page.

Once you have completed the course, you can download a Library membership form as well as links to all the websites highlighted in the eLearning package from the **Additional resources** section.

The Library and Knowledge Service provides you with online access to a range of eBooks on the <u>NHS</u> <u>Knowledge and Library Hub</u> with your OpenAthens account.

The eBook providers are listed under the heading **Other Resources:**

- Oxford University Press Books: the NHS OUP National Collection, providing medical and healthcare books online to support staff and students on placement. To access click on:
 - Access the collection.
 - Choose Off-site sign in.
 - Go to the left hand menu and see
 Format, then select Book. All available titles will be displayed.
- **eBook Central:** access to titles in a variety of subject areas such as Health, Medicine and Nursing:
 - Select Browse Subjects
 - Click on the different subject areas to see titles.
- Kortext NHS eBooks: subject areas include nursing, health management, primary care, general practice, mentoring and coaching:
 - o Click on Kortext Library
 - Either Browse by subject or view All books by clicking on See more.
